# UoC Asymptomatic COVID-19 Screening Programme: 4th – 10<sup>th</sup> Oct 2021

Report author – Dr Isobel Ramsay, Clinical Lead. Report prepared – 11/10/2021. This report does not include results from lateral flow tests (LFTs), or from students or staff tested by PCR using the NHS or University symptomatic testing pathway.

### **Participation**

All 31 Colleges of the University of Cambridge and 4 Houses of the Cambridge Theological Federation participated in the screening programme. Students arriving in Cambridge who were unable to take part in the programme were eligible for additional individual "Return to Cambridge" tests.

We estimate that there are currently **16,065** students present in Cambridge and resident in College accommodation. Approximately **80%** of these students have agreed to participate in the screening programme, of whom **37%** contributed a swab.

### **Students screened**

All participating students present in Cambridge and resident in either College **or** private accommodation were invited to take part, provided they did not meet pre-determined exclusion criteria.

**1506** pooled samples were received and processed at the testing facility. Of these, **3** were reported as "void" (void results may occur for a variety of reasons, including inappropriate packaging or leaking samples).

In total, **4524** students contributed to pooled sample collection, including **4519** students with valid results.

## **Results**

The final pooled screening test results were:

Members of the **1** positive pool were invited for individual confirmatory tests. **1** student from this pool had a positive individual confirmatory test.

Additionally, **103** asymptomatic students were screened individually (individual tests may include: "Return to Cambridge" tests, for students arriving in Cambridge; "Pre-departure" tests, for students leaving Cambridge; confirmatory PCR tests, following positive LFTs; "Test to check" tests, for students already self-isolating as contacts; and tests for enhanced contact tracing). Altogether **0** students tested positive for SARS-CoV-2.
